Noarail Access

I have been playing with the controls and settings for our website and have set up a gallery much like the one on RailpageTM except ours will be usable 99% of the time and has much more bandwidth. This is where club members can upload their photos, files or any other items of interest for the benefit of other feroequineologists.

There is no charge for this service but you must be a financial NMRI member. If you would like to take part in this, send an email to admin@noarail.com with the name you want for your first album (default is your name) and your user name. I will setup the album with a temporary password, which you can login with and change to your preference, and email you when it is ready.

Users can create, rename, delete and set permissions for viewing, etc. all files in their album and any sub albums that they create. I have set the default viewing at 800 x 600 pixels max but there is no limit on full size photos as we currently have plenty of space and bandwidth available and there is an option for the viewer to select either the standard or full size photos.

Aaron is the first to use this service and you can access his files (39 photos plus 5 movie files at the time of writing this) via the main page of our site <u>noarail.com</u> or via the Photo Gallery page. Follow the Member's Gallery link, which is located on the left in the links bar or the one near the top of the Photo Gallery page.

Club members can also have an email address as [user name]@noarail.com, same deal, send me a user name and I will set it up for you.

Do not have internet access? No problem, speak to me at the club and I can set it up for you to access from the clubrooms/libraries, etc.
